INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Start by pulling back brake hood covers and taping cable housing to your bars in a few spots. You will also need a pair of scissors within reach as you move through the process.

STEP 2: Place the tape on the underside of the drop end of the bar with half a width of tape extending beyond the end of the bar. NOTE: When looking at the bar in riding position, wrap clockwise on the right side and counterclockwise on the left.

STEP 3: Tightly wrap around the bar up to the brake hood clamp. Overlap each layer by 1/3 - 1/2 the tape width. If you desire more comfort, we recommend a 1/2 tape overlap.

STEP 4: As you approach the brake clamp, place the 3-inch piece of bar tape over the brake hood clamp (trim as needed).

STEP 5: Wrap closely around the bottom and inside of the brake hood clamp and then continue over the top of the bar.

STEP 6: Continue wrapping until you are about 1.5 inches from the stem.

STEP 7: Trim the end of the tape at an angle so it ends flush with the final wrap. Use the finishing tape to secure the end of the bar tape.

STEP 8: Fold the overlapping bar tape into the handlebar end. Insert the bar end plugs into the end of the handlebars and tighten with the included 3mm hex wrench.
